TIGER BAGS

Tiger Striped Bags (Offensive Waste): These are used for non-hazardous but unpleasant waste, such as dressings, nappies, or incontinence pads that are not infectious. Although offensive, the waste is not dangerous and can be disposed of in a more standardised way, such as through energy recovery processes like municipal incineration. (GOV.UK)

ORANGE BAGS

Orange Bags (Hazardous Infectious Waste): These are used for infectious clinical waste, which may pose a risk of spreading infection. They are suitable for items like dressings, swabs, and PPE contaminated with infectious bodily fluids but free from chemicals, pharmaceuticals, or cytotoxic materials. Waste in orange bags can be treated through alternative methods like heat disinfection, but it must not contain anatomical waste or medicines (GOV.UK)



YELLOW BAGS WITH WRITING

Yellow Bags with Black Writing (Hazardous Waste for Incineration Only): These bags are for highly hazardous waste that must be incinerated at high temperatures. This includes waste contaminated with medicines, cytotoxic, cytostatic chemicals, or any hazardous materials that can't be treated by alternative processes. Anatomical waste, chemical-contaminated items, and pharmaceuticals fall into this category (GOV.UK)
